

DUNWOODY SENIOR BASEBALL, INC. COVID-19 MITIGATION PROCEDURES

BEFORE YOU CAN PLAY

- All coaches and players must have signed the DSB COVID-19 waiver. Players under 18 will have to have their waiver signed by a parent or guardian. NO WAIVER = NO PLAY. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- No person who is quarantined after exposure to a COVID-19 infected person may be on the premises.

MASKS – EVERYONE AT THE PARK MUST WEAR A MASK AT ALL TIMES

- All Coaches will wear masks at all times.
- All umpires will wear masks at all times.
- All DSB Field Managers and representatives will wear masks at all times.
- All Spectators must wear masks at all times or sit outside the outfield fence.
- **FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS RULE WILL RESULT IN THE GAME BEING CANCELLED, EVEN WHILE IN PROGRESS.**

DUGOUTS

- Dugouts are open with designated seating to maintain appropriate social distancing.
- Covered seating outside the dugout is available for anyone not wanting to use the dugout.
- Ventilation fans will run in each dugout while in use.
- Coaches, parents and all other non-players may not enter the dugout at any time.

FANS

- Spectators must bring their own seats.
- Bleachers and picnic tables are off limits.
- Spectators must maintain a safe social distance of six feet from other spectators, players, coaches, and umpires.
- DSB reserves the right to direct or restrict where spectators can sit.

RULES OF PLAY

- All players and coaches will maintain at least six feet social distance except on the field of play during a game.
- Warm-up activity can take place anywhere in the park, including all concourse areas and across the street in Brook Run park. At least six feet social distance must be maintained during warm-ups, in the cages and in the bullpens.
- Umpires will call balls and strikes from behind the mound and wear a mask at all times.
- There will be no contact between players other than during play. That is, no high fives, hugging or shaking hands at any time.
- There will be no pregame coaches meeting at the plate.
- Equipment may not be shared. This includes helmets, catcher's gear, gloves, sweat bands, uniform hats, and shoes.
- Arriving teams will enter via the gates at the end of the dugouts but never through the dugouts.
- At conclusion of the game, teams will leave through the field gates in the outfield.
- DSB will make hand sanitizers and other disinfectant materials available for those that attend events at the Park.
- Coaches are encouraged to ensure that each player and coach has access to disinfectant wipes or other cleaning materials, as appropriate.
