



Rules and Procedures at the Brook Run Park Baseball Fields

- Use of the facilities is an assumed risk by each individual.
- Dugouts will be closed. Buckets for players will be placed in the area that is normally the bullpen at least 6 feet apart.
- Pitchers may warm up in the foul territory on the field, with a catcher and a player protecting them (with a glove and helmet).
- Umpires will call the plate from behind the pitcher.
- Umpires must wear a mask at all times around players.
- Coaches must wear a mask at all times around players.
- Teams enter field by gates beyond the dugouts and leave via outfield gates.
- Social distancing in the cages and warmup areas.
- Teams are encouraged to use the grass area above the East Field, the football field behind the West Field and/or the grass area across Barclay Drive for pregame warmups.
- No sharing of equipment.
- No shared team liquids or food.
- Bleachers have been removed from the facility. Spectators should bring their own chair.
- Spectators must practice social distancing and are encouraged to wear masks. DSB reserves the right to direct or restrict where spectators sit and to restrict crowd size.
- No tobacco, seeds, nuts, gum or metal cleats anywhere in the complex.
- Inside spaces (conference room, storage rooms and all others) are reserved for DSB staff only; no exceptions.

Perfect Game Responsibilities

- Ensure that all coaches and player families have signed a waiver recognizing risks of the virus.
- Ensure rules are followed.
- Perform crowd control.
- Provide hand sanitizer.
- Provide masks for coaches and umpires as needed.
