COVID-19 GUIDELINES FOR JACK HUGHES PARK



ALL Players, Coaches, and Spectators 5 years and older are **REQUIRED** to wear a mask at ALL times. NC Dept. of Health Exceptions: anyone with a disability, behavioral condition or medical concern including an adult or child who has trouble breathing.

ALL Participants **MUST** sign a Town of Pineville waiver before play at Jack Hughes Park.

No more than 50 people on a field.

Recommended that parents/spectators remain in their vehicle during field use.

Field users **MUST** provide your own hand sanitizer. Restrooms will be available.

Players/Coaches **MUST** employ social distancing of 6 feet on the sidelines and during training as much as possible.

Players/Coaches must employ social distancing of their personal bags/belongings 6 feet apart.

Players/Coaches will **NOT** be permitted to shake hands, high five, fist bump, etc.

Players/Coaches will **NOT** be allowed to share equipment or water.

Spitting will **NOT** be permitted.

Recommended to bring your own water/water bottles to limit the use of the water fountains.

Recommended to wash hands thoroughly before and after field use.

Players/Coaches are encouraged to work out in the same groups consistently to limit exposure.

Coaches will discourage play congregation and gatherings as much as possible. NO close-in team huddles, no close lines in training, etc. will be permitted.

Coaches/Players **MUST** avoid up close face to face communication.

Common areas such as door knobs, rails, gates, water fountains, and restrooms will be cleaned/disinfected on a regular/daily basis by P&R staff.
