THESE RESTRICTIONS ARE IN EFFECT FOR ALL TOWN OF HUNTERSVILLE OPERATED FIELDS BEGINNING February 16th, 2021.

UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE. Subject to Change based on state or local guidelines and any future Executive Orders

- ALL RESTRICTIONS AND REQUIREMENTS WILL BE ENFROCED BY THE TOURNAMENT/FIELD DIRECTOR OF EACH ORGANIZATION THAT IS RENTING THE FIELDS. FAILURE TO ENFORCE THESE RESTRICTIONS WILL IMPACT THE ABILITY TO FINISH THE TOURNAMENT AS WELL AS THE ABILITY TO HOST FUTURE TOURNAMENTS WITH THE TOWN OF HUNTERSVILLE.
- NO GATES FOR COLLECTING ENTRANCE FEES
- ALL COACHES, PLAYERS, UMPIRES, SUPPORT STAFF AND SCOREKEEPERS MUST WEAR MASK AT ALL TIMES.
- ALL FANS/SPECTATORS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR MASK AT ALL TIMES.
- Adhere to the Mass Gathering Limits. Max 100 spectators in a venue space as described below:
 - <u>Detailed Guidance for Outdoor Field Sports (provided by NCDHHS)</u>:
 - The Mass Gathering limit of 100 individuals outdoors applies to groups of people who gather together in a park, which would include an outdoor baseball, outdoor soccer, or other outdoor sports field.
 - Accordingly, each youth, amateur, or collegiate sports team may have up to 25 individuals participate in outdoor sports practice or competition, which includes athletes, coaches, trainers and other support staff.
 - Spectators or other attendees at outdoor sports practice or competitions, provided they are separated from the outdoor field by at least 6 feet, are subject to a separate 100-person cap. Each outdoor baseball, outdoor soccer, or other outdoor field, if part of a larger outdoor sports complex, may be counted separately. By way of example, if there are 5 adjoining outdoor soccer fields as part of an outdoor sports complex, each of the 5 fields may have up to 25 individuals on each sports team (counted as described above), with up to 100 spectators on each field."

FANS /SPECTATORS

- EACH FIELD IS ALLOWED UP TO A MAXIMUM OF 100 SPECTATORS
- Fans/Spectators are required to wear mask at all times.
- No spitting seeds or gum is permitted on grounds.
- Spectators may bring tents, but tents will be limited to same household only.

• We highly recommend that that all Coaches, Umpires, Participants and Spectators bring and use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol and USE FREQUENTLY.

PLAYERS & COACHES

- Players & coaches will have designated areas during game to keep everyone spread out.
- Only ROSTERED Coaches are allowed in dugout and it is a maximum of 4 per team.
- We encourage all parents to supply their players with antibacterial wipes and hand sanitizer for disinfecting between innings.
- No Handshakes, fist bumps or high-fives before, during or after the game. Coaches should ensure that players are adhering to social distancing while not on the playing field.
- Whenever possible equipment and personal items should have proper separation and not be shared. Players and Coaches must wear PPE items. Make sure those items do not inhibit a player's safety while participating on field.
- NO Post game meetings. If you are not playing back to back games then all fans, players and coaches need to exit the facility immediately after the conclusion of the game to cut down on foot traffic in the same area.
