Welcome to the MidAmerican Energy RecPlex. The RecPlex features nearly 300,000 square feet including space for sporting events, conventions, concerts, community events, business meetings, corporate gatherings and adaptive recreation.

With over 66 acres of land, the Recplex features three outdoor artificial turf fields including lights and wireless internet. Onsite parking includes space for 1,000 vehicles as well as bike paths and pedestrian areas.





The HyVee Fieldhouse features 150,000 square feet of recreational space including four basketball courts, three pickleball courts, four batting cages and a full-sized artificial turf field featuring scoreboards and sound system.

With a clear ceiling height of 56 feet and over 70,000 square feet of open space, the indoor turf field has space to accommodate a wide range of sports including soccer, football, lacrosse, baseball and softball.





The main arena has a seating capacity up to 2,400 people for dry floor events. It will feature ice opportunities during winter months and can convert to a 20,000 square foot convention space during spring and summer months with the ability to host concerts, conventions and expos.

A variety of meeting and programming space is located throughout the new facility. The Kum & Go Multipurpose rooms can accommodate gatherings as large as 350 people with the option to divide rooms into smaller more intimate areas. The Overlook Room (275 seats) and Community Room (80 seats) have space for smaller events such as birthday parties.





The 3,500 square foot Esports Center will offer space for the fastest growing sport in the world. Featuring over 30 high end, water cooled PC's and six consoles this space will serve as a hub for both elite and amateur gamers.

Located inside the facility and adjacent to the main commons, the Des Moines University Clinic Physical Therapy Center will feature over 5,000 square feet and will serve as the exclusive sports performance and rehabilitation provider at the RecPlex. In addition to daily services, the University will offer athletic training for tournaments and events held both inside and outside the venue.
