2019 TOURNAMENT RULES *High School*

All 2019 high school events will be sanctioned by Perfect Game Baseball.

Any rule not addressed below will revert back to Perfect Game Baseball official rules (link attached below)

- Birthday Cutoff is May 1st, 2019. Teams must have player birth certificates upon request of Tournament Director. Failure to provide documentation of players age will be declared ineligible and if played in a game will be a forfeit.
- Rain out policy: 0 games played 100% refund, 1 game played 50% refund, 2 or more no refund
- No refunds will be awarded if team drops out of event within 15 days of event start date.
- All games have a 1:45 time limit. (Championship games have no time limit)
- Teams must be prepared to start 20 minutes prior to slotted game time.
- Unless otherwise noted by Tournament director, no infield practice will be allowed prior to games.
- Teams are permitted to take ground balls/fly balls in the outfield prior to games.
- Championship rounds: Teams advancing out of pool play will be seeded based on records. Higher seeds will have option of home/away team.
- Home team in pool play determined by coin flip at ground rules.
- Tie Breakers: Head to head, run differential, runs allowed, runs scored, coin flip
- Max run differential +/- 8 per game (forfeits will be assessed a 8-0 score).
- Teams may bat 9, 10, or entire roster. Team may use DH & EH in same lineup if desired
- Re-entry rule applies to all starting players. Pitcher may not re-enter as pitcher
- Tie games in pool play reaching the 1:45 time limit will result in a tie (Inning started before 1:45 will be finish)
- Due to inclement weather, games will be considered complete after 4 innings or 1 hour of game play
- Metal cleats are not allowed on turf fields. Natural surface fields allow metal spikes.
- * All age groups are subject to balks without warnings
- No external music/speakers allowed to be played by teams/fans
- Players/Coaches/Fans must leave immediately if ejected. If ejected twice will be disqualified from remainder of event.
- If team would like to protest/appeal game a \$100 fee for the protest must be provided before ruling.
